CORE JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Employee Support and Management

- Participate in educational and professional programs and/or review appropriate literature on an on-going basis to maintain knowledge and competency in current and developing techniques, professional standards, and services affecting extraction of oils for Company products.

Extraction

- Responsible for developing, implementing and monitoring extraction laboratory procedures
- Manage all extraction activities of the Company for all products for patients.
- Responsible for quality control of all products produced and distributed by the Company.

Compliance / Quality Assurance

- Assist with development and implementation of quality improvement programs to meet the Company standards.
- Evaluate quality control and quality assurance statistics and modifies SOPs, as needed.

Reports and Documentation

- Maintain accurate records of all extraction activities.
